

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
RESOLUTION NO. 2018-275**

**AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE CONTRIBUTION
FOR SINGLE DENTAL COVERAGE TO THE AMOUNT OF \$20.00 PER
MONTH FOR EMPLOYEES NOT COVERED BY A COLLECTIVE
BARGAINING AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2013-65, the Township Committee authorized a contribution in the sum of \$15.00 per month towards the cost of single dental coverage; and

WHEREAS, the contract between the Township and FMBA representing Police Dispatchers requires a contribution for single dental coverage in the sum of \$15.00 per month, the contract between the Township and CWA Local 1036 requires a contribution for single dental coverage in the sum of \$20 per month, the contract between the Township and Teamsters requires a contribution for single dental coverage in the sum of \$20 per month, and the contract between the Township and the PBA requires no contribution; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator recommends that the contribution for those employees who are not represented by a bargaining unit be increased to the amount of \$20.00 per month towards single dental coverage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, New Jersey, that effective January 1, 2019, those employees not subject to a collective bargaining agreement and who receive dental coverage shall be required to contribute the sum of \$20.00 per month towards the cost of single dental coverage, an increase of \$5 per month from the current amount of \$15.00 per month.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contribution for dependent coverage shall remain unchanged.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to implement the deduction as described above.
