**AUTHORIZING ACCEPTING K-9 DOG “NIKITA”
AND ACKNOWLEDGING DONATION FROM

WHEREAS, On October 9, 2020, the Warren Township Police Department took possession of a 1 year old German Shepherd named “Nikita” which is the department’s second K-9 dog; and

WHEREAS, “Nikita” was raised in Slovak Republic and purchased from Connecticut Canine Services; and

WHEREAS, “Nikita” was purchased through a donation made by Anthony Mitlo, a resident of the Township of Warren; and

WHEREAS, the handler for “Nikita” is Officer Bryan Horst, a 17 year veteran of the Warren Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Officer Horst and his new partner “Nikita” will begin their extensive 26 week training course at the Bergen County Sheriff’s Office K-9 Unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Warren hereby extend their appreciation and gratitude to Anthony Mitlo for his generous donation of \$7950 for the purchase of “Nikita”.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Committee hereby accepts the donation of “Nikita” and assigns the K9 to the Police Department.
