 SUTPHEN CORPORATION – CHANGE ORDER #1
 SUTPHEN INTERNATIONAL PUMPER/WESTSIDE TANKER FS19IIE01

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2021 the Township Committee of the Township of Warren by Resolution No. 2021-220, awarded a contract to Sutphen Corporation for the purchase of an International Pumper/Westside Tanker FS19IIE01 for the Warren Township Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Kenworth T800 Chassis with a Cummins Engine that was included in the original purchase is on backorder and will delay the purchase for more than one year; and

WHEREAS, the Community Fire Truck Committee, with the approval of the Fire Chief, has recommended that the Kenworth T800 Chassis with a Cummins Engine be substituted with a PACCAR MAX 13 with 510 HP 1850 LB TQ Engine and requests approval of the change order; and

WHEREAS, the manufacturer will be sharing the cost of the substitution with the Township resulting in a change of \$2,852.00; and

WHEREAS, a certificate showing the availability of funds for this contract in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-14.5 shall be provided by the Chief Financial Officer and made a part thereof, indicating that the appropriation for the within expenditure is charged to the following account, #x-04-55-917-6003.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren that the Fire Chief and Township Administrator have confirmed and executed the change order summarized below:
